### DEAR PARENTS OF AND STUDENT,

**FYI:** Some of our brochures have set schedules which we no longer have. We now accept students starting on any day that we offer class year round except for our Morning Summer classes where we take pre-registration only. (Please print a calendar online on our home page for March through August date information).

Thank you for your interest in our Classic Drivers Education program. If you would like to attend our strip mall location program at 36th Ave. N. & HWY 169, our directions & class calendar are posted on our website by clicking on the **new hope** link on the left side or center of the home page. Our address is 9409 – 36<sup>th</sup> Ave. N. in New Hope 55427. [Google Map](#)

Our package price for 30hours of class and 6 hours of Behind the Wheel training will be **\$350**. (Don't forget about our Grade & Friends Discounts for pricing as low as **\$325**!) You must be at least 14years & 9 months old to register and take our Classroom & Behind the Wheel training.

If you would like our payment plan option, we ask for a minimum of a \$100 deposit on your 1<sup>st</sup> day of class. We then give you three weeks to pay the remaining balance and you may take longer than that if you'd like, but there is an additional \$20 finance charge if you do so. We accept Cash, Checks, Visa, or MasterCard. (credit card payments for paid in full only)

Also remember that although we take pre-registrations, we also take walk-ins everyday and you may start on any Monday through Friday by arriving 5 minutes prior to class starting. Each student must complete all class letters A through J without repeating the same letter. You may take the classes in any order but must complete all 10 classes within 6 months. However, it only takes about 2 & ½ weeks to complete the course, while most students finish within 1 to 3 months depending on other activities in which they are involved in.

*Real Life Stories...Real Life Consequences....*

***"Dead is dead and sorry ain't good enough"***

***Jon Cummings, founder of the Minnesotans for Safe Driving***

This driver impact panel will feature speakers from the **Minnesotans for Safe Driving**, an organization dedicated to victim's advocacy. These speakers share real life stories of the tragic consequences of motor vehicle crashes. These panels are for both parents and drivers education students.

The National Safety Council and the Center from Disease Control report that traffic crashes are the leading cause of death among persons age 1-34 and the 5th leading cause of death among all persons. There is also a huge economic impact as well. The National Safety Council estimates that each fatality results in an economic loss of \$1.9 million per fatality and in 2006 the total loss was over \$7 billion dollars.

In 2006, 494 people were killed in traffic crashes in Minnesota and over 40,000 nationwide. And, young drivers are "over represented" in the crash statistics. We use the term CRASH because the word accident implies a random, unavoidable quality to an event. Most CRASHES can be avoided or minimized by changes in our individual human behavior. We are hoping that by hearing first-hand these tragic stories all drivers will be motivated to start taking responsibility for their actions behind the wheel of a motor vehicle. We also hope parents will be convinced of the importance of practice driving, driving limits, and experience.
