Comprehensive Traffic Safety Program

Classroom Phase: This phase includes 30 hours of classroom instruction that prepares novice teen drivers to take the Minnesota Instruction Permit Exam and to accept the responsibility of driving.

Behind the Wheel Phase: This phase of training takes place in the car and focuses on risk identification & management as well as courteous defensive driving skills. Each student will receive 6 hours of instruction, an In-Car Instruction Manual©, a written evaluation after each lesson, as well as a driving experience log to help parents track practice hours. Well trained, patient instructors help make it count. Each lesson will begin and end at a district campus.

Parent Participation Phase: Parent attendance is required in order to qualify for enrollment in behind the wheel training. This lesson is designed to aid parents in working with their teen drivers.

Driving Impact Panel: These are scheduled regionally around the metro area and while they are not required, these panels offer a very important opportunity to hear the personal and tragic stories of people who have been impacted by car crashes. The dates for the impact panel will be posted at mytwheels.com.
