1. What are the top 10 things you and your child need to know? (found on “Top 10 Check list” given to you in your student packet or refer to the top ten checklist at mytwheels.com)

2. How many hours of practice do we ask you to have before your first behind the wheel? 5 to 10 hours
3. What are the top 4 reasons why Teens Crash? Poor Visual Search Habits, Inattention, Speed Management, Space Management
4. What is the number one factor in multiple car crashes when a Teen is the driver? Driver Distraction / Inattention
5. What is the number one factor in single car crashes when a Teen is the driver? Illegal or unsafe speed
6. What is the Zero Tolerance Law? Alcohol use for persons under 21 is prohibited. A blood alcohol level for a person under 21 that registers above 0% will be charged with DWI
7. Who is more at risk for fall asleep crashes, Older or Younger Drivers? Younger
8. What are the three stages in the Graduated Drivers Licensing system? Stage 1 – Learner’s Permit, Stage 2 – Intermediate/Probationary License, Stage 3 – Full/Unrestricted License

9. What type of topics regarding traffic safety needs to be discussed with your teen?
 - Curfew – Flight plan
 - Hours permitted to drive
 - Number of passengers
 - Driving restrictions
 - Car maintenance
 - Concerns about driving while fatigued, distracted, intoxicated, or emotional
 - Defensive driving
10. Why is it important not to lose your white slip? The state of MN requires you to have your white slip with to take your road test. It will cost \$15 to re-issue a duplicate white slip.
11. What is the law in MN for the use of cell phones? Refer to the website at mytweels.com and look for the new cell phone laws for teen's link.
12. What do you always have to have with you when you go to your behind the wheel lessons? Valid Permit, Proper shoes, glasses or contacts(if you need them), fuel payment(if in affect), driving log, In-Car Instruction Manual.
13. What kind of shoes do you need to be wearing for behind the wheel lessons?
Normal Tennis Shoes. No flip flops, sandals or boots.
14. Will your student receive an evaluation after each behind the wheel lesson? Yes
15. How old must you be to receive your permit? 15 years old
16. Where is the nearest exam station to take your permit test? (see permit study guide)
17. Why is it important to make full stops at stops signs? It gives you reaction time and time to be observant and plus It's the law(for a reason).
18. What options do you have if you can't attend the driver's impact panel? Journal assignments(found on your points sheet in student folder)
19. What does it cost if a student misses a behind the wheel lesson? \$50
20. How many hours of practice does the State of MN Department of Public Safety require parents(legal guardian) to practice with their teen? 30 hours Minimum, Although we recommend at least 50 hours plus!
21. How many Behind the Wheel lessons are there? Three(they are each 2 hours long)
22. Do you call T-Wheels to schedule Behind the Wheel lessons? No, an assigned Instructor will call you to set up your lessons.

23. How long should it take to complete the 6 hours of Behind the Wheel lessons?
The three lessons are spread out 4 to 5 months
24. What are the 5 reasons for a Behind the Wheel lesson with your Instructor from Training Wheels? To Reinforce or Perfect Good Driving Habits, To focus on Risk Awareness, For Constructive Criticism and Praise, To Perfect Defensive Driving Skills and To Reinforce an Attitude that Traffic Safety Matters
25. What are the 7 outlined habits that Safe Drivers Do?
1. They are clear on the concept that the word “STOP” on the sign doesn’t mean “slow down” or “almost stop”
 2. They yield the right-of-way when required
 3. They don’t speed through intersections on yellow lights and they certainly don’t enter intersections after the light has turned red
 4. They don’t tailgate, because they drive under the assumption that the vehicle in front may need to stop suddenly, and that if it does, they would rear-end that vehicle (*if a driver is less than three seconds behind the vehicle he/she is following, that driver is too close*)
 5. They obey the basic speed law (“don’t drive faster than conditions allow”) and the posted limit
 6. They do not use the cell phone to take or make calls when they are moving or sitting in traffic (*recall the stats on distracted driving ...*)
 7. They stop before crosswalks
26. Is there a cost to renew your contract with us after one year when it expires? Yes, and the required fees are \$175 for 6hrs of Behind the Wheel left to do, \$150 for 4hrs and \$125 for 2hrs left.
